



VEHICLE TECH RULES

THE TECH OFFICIAL HAS FINAL SAY ON ALL RULINGS OR DISCREPANCIES. THESE RULES MAY CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE OR PUBLICATION.

DRIVERS

- Must be 18+ and have a valid driver's license. A learner's license is not accepted.
- Must sign an insurance waiver.
- No passengers are permitted.

EQUIPMENT

- SNELL- or DOT-approved helmets.
- Full length pants—no spandex or shorts.
- No muscle shirts or tank tops.
- Closed-toe footwear.

VEHICLES

- No debris or loose items (including in the trunk).
- Street tires are DOT-approved and in good condition. Slicks or competition slicks are in good condition.
- If running slicks, must have an approved driveshaft safety loop.
- Hub caps must be removed.
- Lug nuts must be tight, with none missing. If running wrinkle walls, you must have approved studs and nuts.
- All steering components must be in good condition, with proper hardware and fasteners only. Steering system must be in working order.
- Brakes must be in good condition, and in working order.
- Must be equipped with seat belts, lap belts at a minimum.
- OEM glass must be intact, without spider cracking. Rock chips and cracks are okay, as long as driver's vision isn't obstructed. Tech will have final say.

- Cooling system must be in good working condition. Must include an overflow tank with at least 1 L capacity.
- Fuel pressure gauge must be mounted on the outside of the vehicle or under the hood (if equipped). No more than 12" of consecutive rubber fuel line is permitted.
- All fuel pumps need to be part of the engine, internal in the tank, or outside the vehicle. NO fuel pumps in the trunk.
- Must have a functioning neutral safety switch.
- No loose or missing suspension bolts or components. Declare suspension modifications to Tech.
- Absolutely no leaks from cooling system, engine, transmission, brakes, or differential. Vehicles with leaks will not be allowed to run.
- Firewall must be functional and practical.
- Battery must be solid mounted (no Bungee cords).
- Batteries in the trunk must have an external disconnect.
- All traction aid devices not attached at the front must have a limited strap to prevent surface contact.
- Air clean assemblies required.
- Hoods not required.
- 4x4's must run in 2WD.
- 4x4's must have 4 street-style tires. Boggers are not accepted. (Airport Authority rule.)
- No nitrous or alcohol (Fire Department rule).
- Convertibles that run faster than an 8.95 in the 1/8 mile must have a roll bar (NHRA rule).
