RACERS: What to Do if There's an Emergency Landing

While the airport is closed to general aircraft traffic during the drag race, emergency landings, including medevacs, are still allowed.

The race announcer will announce if an aircraft will be landing.

The airport will give a 20- and 25-minute warning.

RACERS

Pre-Staged: Return to the pits. The south half of the pits need to be cleared. If that's your pit spot, park your car between the south hangers.

If you're in the north half of the pits, return to your assigned spot. This will be reviewed again during the mandatory Driver's Meeting before the race.

Staged: The pilot vehicle will pilot you back, where you will either return to your spot in the north half of the pits or make your way to parking between the south hangers if your spot is in the south half of the pits.

Pits: Cars in the **south half of the pits** must clear the area, as that's where the aircraft turns around. Park your car between the south hangers until the announcer gives the 'all clear'.

North side of pits: Return to your assigned pit spot. Please stay near your car or bike in case you have to move it. If your car or bike is running, you must be in it or on—not standing beside it.
